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HANOVER TOWNSHIP INVITES DEVELOPERS AND BROKERS TO A BUSINESS ROUND-TABLE DISCUSSION

On Friday, October 28, 2011, the Hanover Township Economic Development Advisory Committee (EDAC) will host a "Brokers and Developers Round-Table Discussion" at the Township's Municipal Building located at 1000 Route 10 (at the intersection of Route 10 westbound and North Jefferson Road) in Whippany. The workshop will take place between 8:00 a.m. to 9:30 a.m.

Created in September, 2010, EDAC's mission is to stimulate economic growth both in terms of new economic development and the retention of existing commercial businesses and industries. EDAC is comprised of eleven (11) members representing a cross-section of the corporate and business community including the Mayor and a member of the Township Committee who serves as the Director of Planning. One of EDAC's primary functions is to partner with land owners, prospective developers and the real estate industry in assisting them through the development or redevelopment process.

Some of the topics to be discussed at the round-table meeting will include the Township's proposed new sustainability ordinance; attracting medical professionals to the Township; and providing attendees with information on incentives offered through the State of New Jersey and the Morris County Economic Development Corporation. Key Township department heads will also be on hand to answer any questions or provide insight into the application and approval processes.
